**CalFresh** – also known as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), provides assistance for individuals and families to purchase nutritious food.

**Medi-Cal** – California’s health insurance program for eligible low or no income individuals and families.

**CalWORKs** – Cash assistance and employment services for low or no income families with dependent children.

**General Assistance** – Cash assistance for low or no income adults without dependent children and emancipated minors.

**Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA)** – Financial Assistance for newly-arrived refugees without dependent children.

**Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI)** – Cash assistance for legal non-citizen older adults (65 and older), blind or disabled immigrant residents.
